## Powered Wheelchair & Electric Scooter Assessments

The Disabled Living Centre & Mobility Service provides impartial and independent advice for disabled and older people who wish to trial a powered wheelchair or electric scooter to increase their independence and mobility.

**Our service is free of charge**

### Additional Information

The Centre is wheelchair accessible and has accessible toilets. Limited reserved parking spaces are provided opposite our entrance and there is further free parking on the hospital site.

## Why come to us for an Assessment?

An assessment of your specific needs will be carried out by a qualified Therapist.

### We do not sell electric scooters or powered wheelchairs

The Centre has a selection of different models of electric scooters and powered wheelchairs that are loaned to us by a variety of retailers for assessment and demonstration purposes.

In addition we are able to arrange for specific models to be brought in to meet your particular needs.

### The assessment includes identification of:

- Your physical requirements
- Access issues and the environment in which you wish to use the scooter or wheelchair
- Storage and battery charging issues
- Transportation concerns
- Safety issues

You have the opportunity to practice both indoors within the Centre and on a safe circuit area outdoors.
